Description of Project: For the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration, TEMS completed a demand analysis for the airports in the Chicago region. The study evaluated the demand for existing airports, capacity problems at O'Hare International Airport, and the impact of different locations for the proposed Chicago Third Airport. The study also assessed the impact of rail connections to O'Hare, Rockford, and the sites proposed for the Third Airport. The analysis was evaluated in economic terms and a full cost benefit assessment was made of the role of each airport and its impact on overall regional capacity and travel potential.
